

DAY TRIPPING FROM LAKE LOUISE

Enjoy an afternoon of discovery and wonder in Yoho National Park

- 1:00PM** Depart from Lake Louise and head west on Trans Canada Hwy #1. Approximately 25kms west of Lake Louise is a turn off for **Takakkaw Falls**. Turn right from the Trans Canada onto Yoho Valley Road and follow the road 14kms to the end.
- 1:30PM** Arrive at Takakkaw Falls, Canada's 2nd highest waterfall. "Takakkaw" means magnificent in Cree and these falls definitely are!
- 1:50PM** Get back in your car and continue west for 5 minutes on the Trans Canada. Turn into the town of Field, cross the bridge, and don't leave this road until the **Truffle Pigs Café** is on your right hand side.
- Enjoy a late lunch in this deliciously unique bistro.
- 3:25PM** Get back in your car and keep going west on the Trans Canada. As you pass through Yoho Park enjoy the views of the area's towering rock walls and keep your eyes peeled for wildlife.
- 3:35PM** Turn right from the Trans Canada onto **Emerald Lake Road**. This road curves around the base of Mount Burgess, providing beautiful views of the glacial lake and surrounding mountains. Emerald Lake is one of the jewels of the Canadian Rockies and you will want to take some photos here.
- 4:10PM** Hop back in your car and continue west on the Trans Canada. Wetlands Wildlife Safaris is approximately 40 minutes (53kms) west of Emerald Lake.
- 4:50PM** **Arrive at Wetlands Wildlife Safaris**. Check in at the front desk and enjoy your first view of the Columbia River.
