

DAY TRIPPING FROM LAKE LOUISE

Pack a lunch and enjoy a day of discovery in Yoho National Park

7:45AM Depart from Lake Louise and head west for approximately 80km on Trans Canada Hwy #1. As you exit Yoho National Park keep your eyes peeled for the Golden turn-off.

Continue through the town of Golden, crossing over the Kicking Horse River. Follow our Wetland Tours signs to our guest meeting area, the Watershed.

9:00AM Depart on our shuttle bus for your Wetlands Wildlife Safari.

11:00AM After your guided wetland safari, arrive back at the Watershed for riverside snacks and refreshments. Ask your guide to recommend a great little café to pick-up your picnic lunch (not included).

11:20AM Hop back in your car and return to the Trans Canada Hwy #1. Head east on Hwy #1 and follow the signs towards Banff. After approximately 20mins (38kms) turn left at the **Finn Creek Picnic area**. Enjoy your packed lunch at the picnic tables and take a short stroll along the creek.

Continue east on Hwy #1 for approximately 5 minutes (15kms). Turn left from the Trans Canada onto **Emerald Lake Road**. The road curves around the base of Mount Burgess, providing beautiful views of the glacial lake and surrounding mountains. Emerald Lake is one of the jewels of the Canadian Rockies and you will want to take some photos here!

Get back in your car and keep going east. As you pass through Yoho National Park enjoy the views of towering rock walls and keep your eyes peeled for wildlife. Look for the signs for **Takakkaw Falls**, Canada's 2nd highest waterfall. Turn left onto Yoho Valley Road and follow the road 14kms to the end. "Takakkaw" means magnificent in Cree and these falls definitely are!

Once you finish at the waterfalls, continue on your way back to Lake Louise to relax by the fire and enjoy a tasty meal!
